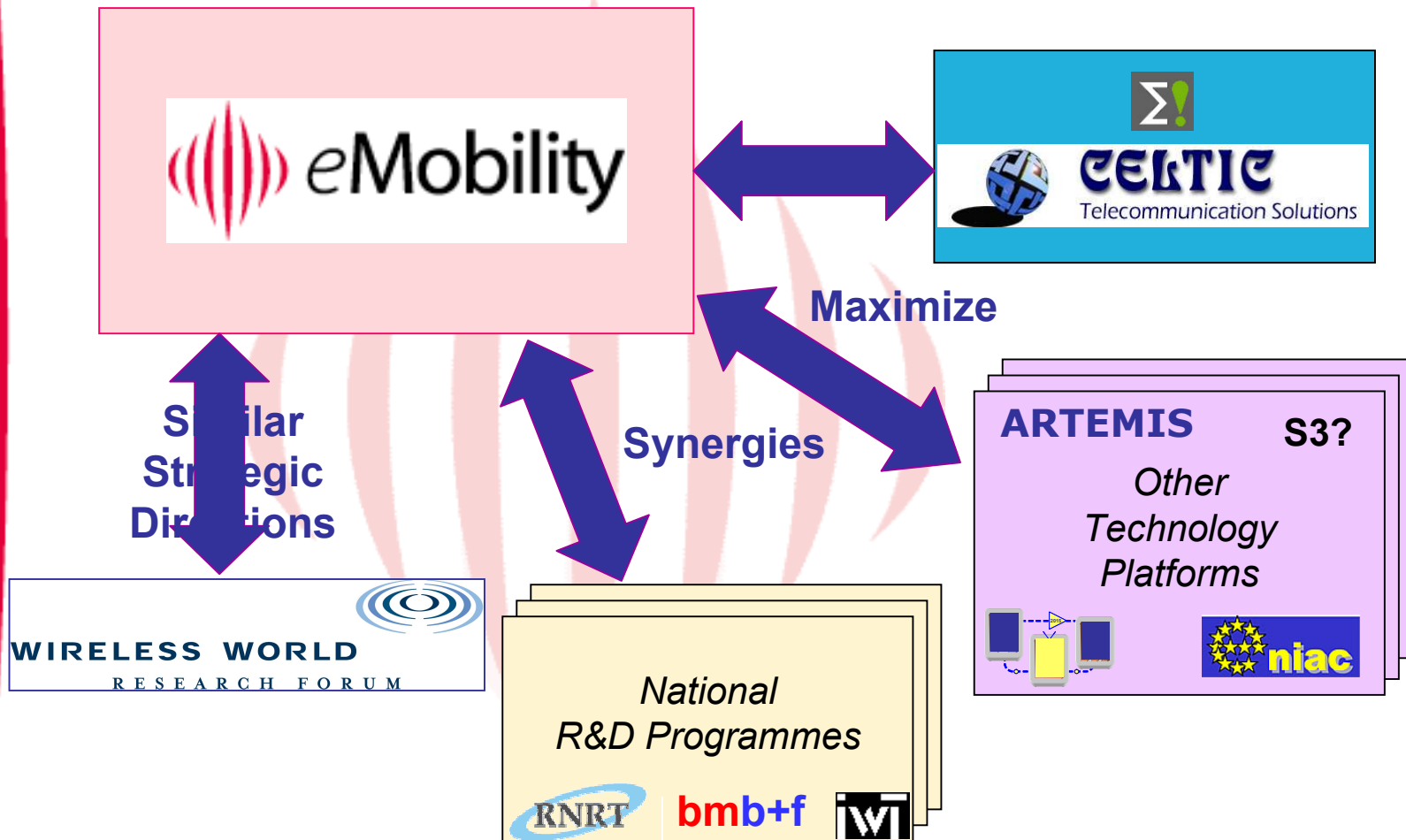

eMobility “Liaisons” Status



- **Coordination with other ICT Technology Platforms**
- **First list of “liaisons” set up + two “Mirror Group” meetings held**
 - **First overview of European landscape of R&D programmes in the area of mobile & wireless communications under way**

Coordination with other ICT eMobility Platforms

- First meeting with NEM (13 June 2005)
- First meeting with ARTEMIS, ENIAC and NEM (7 September 2005)
- Main outcome:
 - The four platforms + NESSI cover the IST area
 - Each of them has a clear focus and there is little overlap between the platforms
 - We will include the NESSI platform in future meetings
 - We agreed to work together to set up a working group to define common positions as a short paper and diagram to represent the relationships between the platforms
 - We agreed to define a common position on how Technology Platforms could influence the 7th Framework Programme, once it is running
 - We agreed to define our views on how the organisation of Commission units could support the platforms in their work.

Inter-ICT Platform Working Group



- 2 representatives from each of the five ICT platforms (ARTEMIS, eMobility, ENIAC, NEM, NESSI)
- 1st deliverable: note agreed by all ICT platforms showing
 - Importance of ICT
 - Synergy between the ICT platforms
(Due end of November)
- 2nd stage: action plan for all appropriate actions that could be common to all ICT platforms
 - New inter-ICT Platform meeting planned before end of the year

 - **DIMES** Association: promotion of Finnish ICT applications industry
 - **ISOC** Belgium: Internet Society
 - **Mobile VCE**: joint initiative between industry, academia and the UK govt
 - **Wireless Future**: Norwegian version of eMobility

- ***Objective: have a first preliminary view of European and national initiatives in the area of eMobility***

- **Next steps**
 - Define specific liaisons with each organization for a win-win situation where both sides will gain from the relationship.
 - Start drawing the landscape of mobile and wireless research in Europe, using inputs from all national representatives and liaison organizations –not to replicate the work!
