SAA & integration in SRA (3)_(B)

- *Since the SAA is being integrated as a chapter of the SRA, there is the need only to update the contents.*
- *We should try to have dissemination of information.*
- *We should try to look into the Work Programme of FP7 Phase 3, and analyse the relationships with the applications.*
- *The contributions to the SAA chapter in the STRA should be structured as challenges that need to be addressed and the ways to overcome them, taking the current version of the SAA as a starting point, as well as the SRA.*
- *Discussion on a new area, Entertainment, expecting that contributions will be given.*
- *Discussion on whether Security should be a separate section or not. It was decided that it will not be a separate section.*
